

The Delta State University/Hinds Community College Partnership (DHP) for Elementary Education Program

Frequently Asked Questions

1. **How may I apply?** The application process has two steps:
 - a. Complete the attached information sheet and email to Dr. Jenetta Waddell (jwaddell@deltastate.edu)
 - b. Apply for admission to Delta State University online at www.deltastate.edu (Application fee is \$25.00.)

2. **What are the admission requirements?**

A student who was eligible for admission to the freshman class at Delta State but chose to attend another institution may transfer at any time as long as the student has a “C” average or better and is eligible to return to that institution.

Any student who was not eligible for admission to the freshman class must attend an accredited institution of higher learning other than one of Mississippi’s eight state-supported universities and attain a “C” average (2.0 G.P.A. on a 4.0 scale) in the following 24 semester credit hours.

- 6 semester hours English Composition
- 3 semester hours College Algebra or above
- 6 semester hours Laboratory Science
- 9 semester hours Transferable Electives

3. **What are tuition costs?** For full-time students (12 – 19 hours), the cost is \$2,124 for in-state and \$3,005 for out-of-state fee. For part-time students, in-state tuition is \$177 per semester hour and \$427 per semester hour for out-of-state.

Details of the **Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship** are as follows: The award for Phi Theta Kappa is \$6,200.00 payable \$1,550.00 for four consecutive semesters. Once at Delta State, students must complete 30 semester hours with a 3.0 to continue eligibility for the last semesters.
