

Pharmacy Technology (AAS-PHM)

Program Description: This curriculum combines classroom instruction with laboratory work and clinical experience to prepare students for employment as technicians. The curriculum includes therapeutic classifications of drugs, generic and trade names, transcription abbreviations, and pharmacy math and dosage calculations. The program of study familiarizes the student with the methods of drug preparation, packaging, and distribution, as well as the functions and services provided by the hospital and retail pharmacy.
